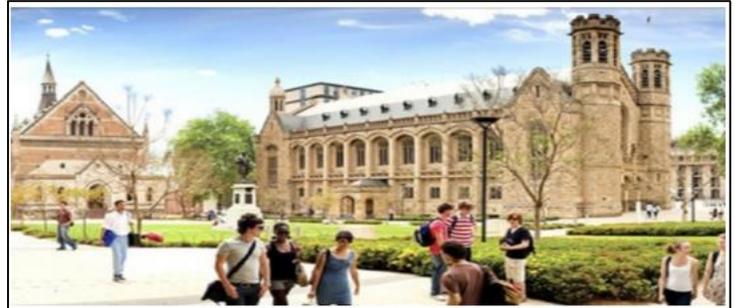


STEP 1: Main menu options:

Three options are available from the main menu:

- **I know what programs I'd like to study** – Locate and select specific programs offered to see how your prior learning may be applied. (STEP 2)
- **I don't know what program I want to study** – Enter any prior learning taken at other institutions to see how they may be applied to programs. (STEP 3)
- **Retrieve previously saved credit estimate** – If you had previously entered and saved your information, prevent having to re-enter it again by retrieving your workspace.



Prior learning at other institutions may be recognised by The University of Adelaide and may count as credit towards your studies at the university.

The Credit Estimator is a guide to the possible credit you may receive at The University of Adelaide based on your prior learning. The Credit Estimator only shows the outcomes of previously assessed credit applications at the university at a particular point in time. You can formally apply for credit when you have been admitted to the university. Entry to the University is subject to its admission requirements that may change from time to time.

If you have an idea of what you want to study, use this function to estimate the credit you may receive if you undertake these programs.

If you are uncertain of what you want to study, use this function to see all the credit you may receive at the university.

STEP 2: Select Programs

Under the **Available Programs**, use the search field to enter keywords for locating programs you are interested in. Select "Add" next to each program to add them to the **Selected Programs** list. Once complete select the **Enter Prior Learning** button to move forward. You may return to this page to change your selected programs.

STEP 3: Add Prior Learning

To begin, use the **Add Learning** button to open the **Add Learning** dialog box (pictured below). Begin typing in the **Provider** field to locate your first provider.

Find Providers and add Prior Learning

Find the institution at which you have previously studied and then select the course(s) you studied at that institution. Note, the institutions and courses listed are only of those The University of Adelaide has assessed in previous credit applications. If you do not find your institution or course, you may still be eligible for credit.
